The European Commission issued the Directive on Data Protection in 1998 prohibiting the transfer of personal data to non-European Union nations that did not meet the European “adequacy” standard for privacy protection. Subsequently, the US Department of Commerce, in conjunction with the European Union, established the Safe Harbor Framework to bridge the gap between the data privacy approaches of the United States and the European Union.
